

Enhancement/Change in the validation of NeSL DDE eBG API

Kind Attention: Bank users

As part of the continuous improvement and various feedback from the stakeholders, we have introduced / undertaken following changes in the NeSL DDE eBG API which will facilitate in better monitoring of eBG information to its stakeholders,

4	Loan	Claim Expiry Date	Optional	Mandatory	Bank Guarantee claim expiry date needs to be passed to ensure beneficiary receives advance alert
5	Entity	Contact Number	Mandatory	Conditional Mandatory	Optional for both applicant and beneficiary

6	Participating	Email ID	Conditional Mandatory	Mandatory	a. For both applicant and beneficiary b. For bank signing in NeSL environment

The above-mentioned changes are introduced in the DDE eBG API 5.1.1. The said changes will be effective in production from 15th August 2024. Post the effective date, the DDE eBG API request will be rejected on account of validation failure for above fields with appropriate message.

We hereby request bank/s to note the above changes and start incorporating in their process design while integrating DDE eBG API. Banks are encouraged to supply the mandatory field information as part of the operational process even in the existing version of API without waiting for system upgrade
