Date: 20th November 2025**e-BG event request by Madhya Pradesh State Excise Department**

The Madhya Pradesh State Excise Department (MPSED), along with all its 52 districts, is registered with NeSL for e-BG. Beginning with the financial year 2025–26, MPSED has mandated the use of e-BGs, and physical BGs are no longer accepted. The Department finds the issuance and management of e-BGs through NeSL to be efficient and practical, effectively addressing the limitations of paper-based BGs.

While raising invocation requests through NeSL platform, bank account number and IFSC code are mandatory fields. However, MPSED does not maintain a bank account linked to the Department. Until now, invocation amounts have been accepted via Demand Drafts (DD) and deposited into the treasury under the relevant major and minor heads.

NeSL and MPSED are actively working toward a permanent solution in the form of introducing DD option which may require changes to the existing APIs used by the banks. In the meantime, as an **interim arrangement**, MPSED will be raising invocation request as provided below and all e-BG issuing banks are requested to accept and process invocation requests with following details from MPSED for payment through Demand Draft mode:

- **Currency** will be selected and **invocation amount** will be entered
- In the **Account holder name**, 'NA' will be entered
- In the **Bank Account** field, MPSED will enter "0"
- In the **Bank Name** field, 'NA' will be entered
- In the **IFSC Code** field, "NA" will be entered.
- In the **Remarks** column, the concerned MPSED district raising the invocation request will specify issuance of a Demand Draft, in line with the current practice followed by MPSED.

This process will be applicable for all MP state departments at present.

In future when system changes are to be undertaken by NeSL for incorporating Demand Draft as a feature, NeSL will notify banks and MPSED of any change in API specifications to be implemented at the banks' side. Meanwhile, all financial institutions are requested to comply with the arrangement outlined above.
