Date: 13<sup>th</sup> March 2026**Clarification on SD calculator for the state of Uttar Pradesh for Digital e-Stamping**

We invite the attention of NeSL DDE users (Registered Banks and NBFCs) to take note of the following changes in the permitted article codes for the state of Uttar Pradesh with effect from 12.03.2026, as per the communication received from M/s SHCIL. The users may take reference to communicate No. Circular No.: NeSL/DDE/2024/0164 dated 27th September 2024:

- a) For all active articles applicable minimum Stamp duty amount is Rs.10 and should be in multiples of 10.
- b) The minimum and maximum Stamp Duty amount has been changed for the article code as per the following table:

Article No.	Digital Stamp Id	Article Name	Min SD limit	Max SD limit
12(A)	1004	Bank Guarantee	50	10000

- c) The following article has been deactivated for usage for DDE Users:

Article No.	Digital Stamp Id	Article Name	Status
48	0011	Power of Attorney	Deactivated

Kindly incorporate necessary changes in your submission process of DDE, Uttar Pradesh Transactions.

NeSL DDE users are advised to select the right article code/stamp duty amount apt for the contract type.
