Vide Letter No. from the Ministry of Finance, Government of India DO No.-06/2/2019-BO.II dt. 11/08/2020 Instructed Chief Secretary, Government of Maharashtra to develop e-signing and e-stamping system by National e-Governance Services Limited (NeSL) for the convenience of citizens as per. As per letter of RBI No. RBI / 2017-18 / 110, DBR.No.Leg.Bbc.98 / 09.08.019 / 2017-18 , dated 19/12/2020, National e-Governance Services Limited (NeSL) is an information utility recognized by the Central Government vide Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India regulation dated 25/09/2017.

In this connection, National e-Governance Services Limited (NeSL) has set up a system with the participating banks for payment of stamp duty under Article 10 (d) of the Maharashtra Stamp Act. AS per Notification No. Extraordinary 4-B No. 269 d as per 23/09/2021 of Govt of Maharashtra, stamp duty will be paid through this system in accordance with the following articles of Maharashtra Stamp Act.
