In reference to the above noted subject matter, this is to inform you that in pursuance of DO No.6/2/2019-BO.II dated 11th August, 2020 of Shri Debasis Panda, Secretary, Department of Financial Services, Government of India and with prior approval of the Finance Department, Government of West Bengal, a suitable system has been developed by the Directorate of Registration and Stamp Revenue, West Bengal, (a Directorate under the Finance Department), as a part its website (<https://wbregistration.gov.in>) for the purpose and the system so developed has been integrated with the DDE Platform of NeSL so as to facilitate NeSL -

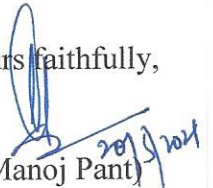
To make payment for paperless digital e-Stamp required by them;

To avail and affix paperless digital e-Stamp of requisite amount for the purpose of execution of loan agreements chargeable under Article 6 of Schedule-IA of the Indian Stamp Act, 1899, as applicable to the State of West Bengal.

UAT of the said system has been successfully done by the concerned team of NeSL and now the system is ready to put into practice.

You are, therefore, requested to take necessary steps for implementing the said integrated system into practice at an early date with a prior intimation to this Department.
