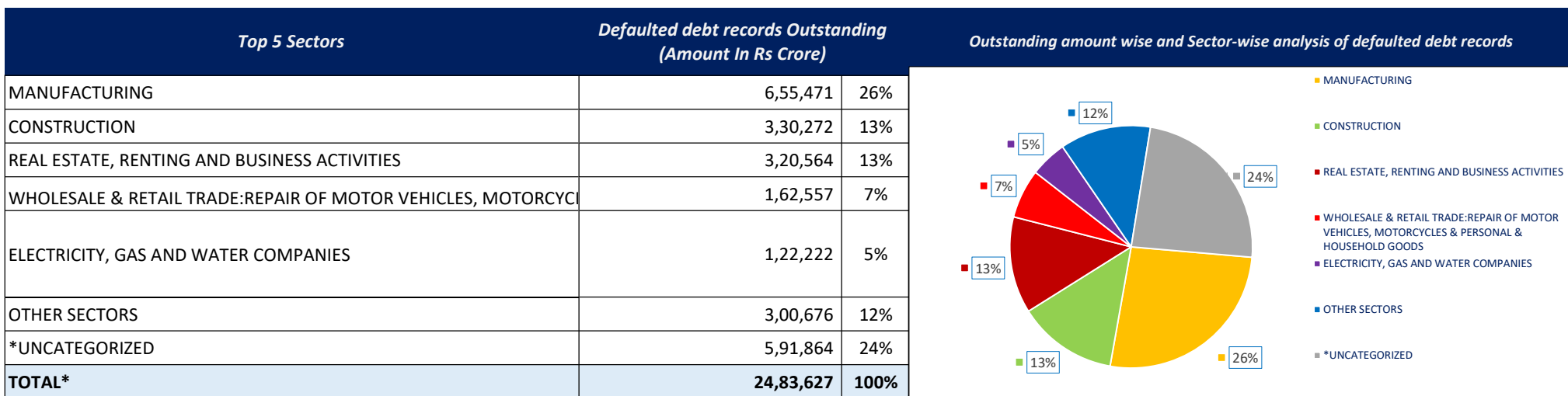
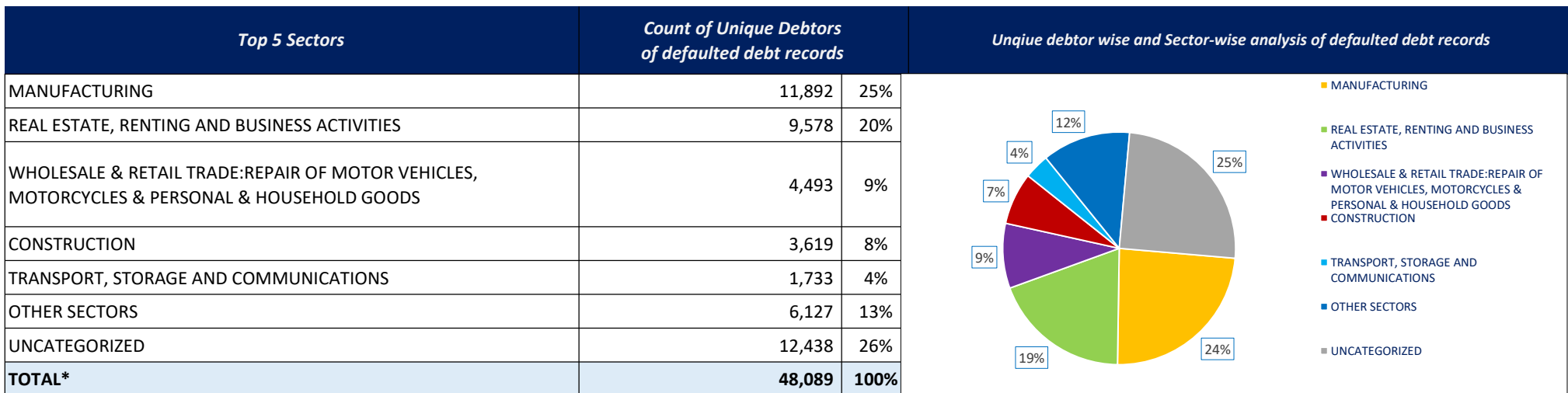
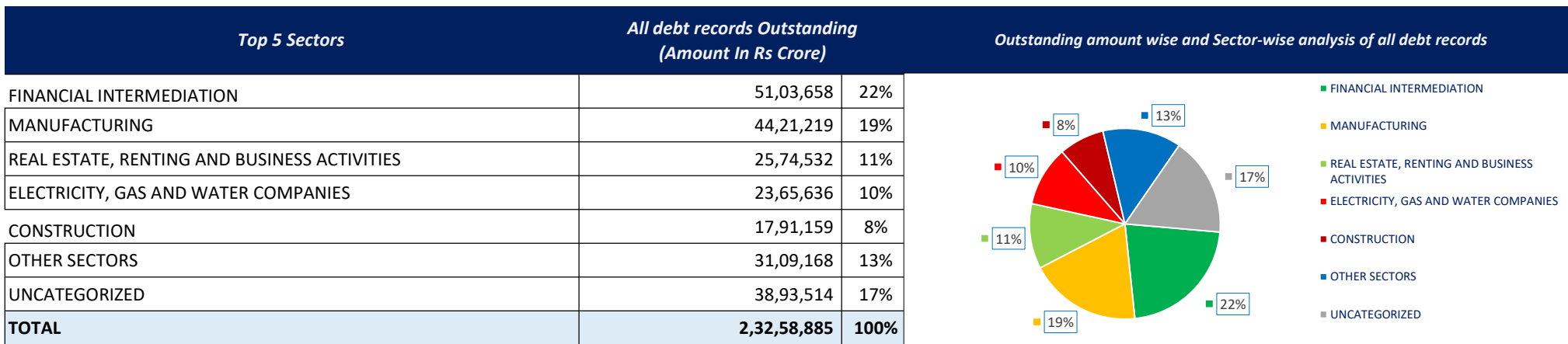
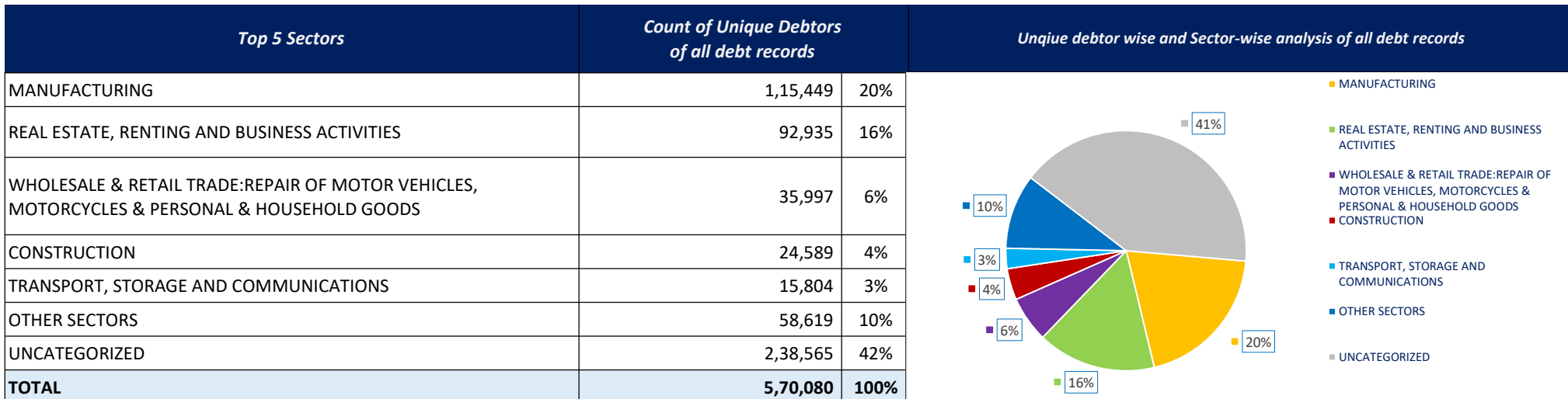




Notes

1	Analysis of the Industry-wise distribution is done on the basis of Industry categorisation available in MCA site (https://www.mca.gov.in/MCA21/dca/efiling/NIC-2004_detail_19jan2009.pdf) and the Primary Industry Code available in Corporate Identification Number (CIN) of the Corporate Debtor.
2	Debt records where CIN isn't available in MCA PAN data mapping are identified as "Uncategorized" state.
3	Data represents records pertaining to debtor category only as "Corpoarte" i.e. where legal constitution of debtor is a Corporate or LLP registered with MCA and/or where debtor name indicates the entity pertains to Corporate category
4	Data includes all types of debts i.e Financial debts and Operational debt; Standard debts and Defaulted debts.
5	Debtor refers to the count of unique debtors (UIN/PAN) being identified for the particular slab. There could be same Debtor having multiple debts being identified in multiple slabs.
7	Debt refers to each record of information reported in Form C to NeSL, identified by a unique debt reference number (e.g. loan account number).
*	Total of debtor count would not be actual sum, as there may exist overlap of data in other categories
