*As per the amended First Schedule of the IT Act, 2000, only a “Power of attorney that empower an entity regulated by the RBI, National Housing Bank, SEBI, IRDAI and PFRDA to act for and behalf of the person executing them” can be digitally executed using DDE services.

The parties remain solely responsible for ensuring that the document being executed on DDE platform under Article 48(a) are optionally registrable under the Registration Act, 1908 as per the Clarification No. LMD-17011/2/2024 dated 12th June 2026, issued by the Department of Land Management (Stamps & Registration Wing), Government of Arunachal Pradesh.
